GENERAL NOTES

1. All members must display current Membership Discs when they are on the course.

2. Ladies may obtain a WHS competition handicap by returning score cards (9 or 18 holes) totalling 54 holes from the red or yellow tees.

3. Gentlemen may obtain a WHS competition handicap by returning score cards (9 or 18 holes) totalling 54 holes from the white or yellow tees.

4. It is no longer a requirement to return three cards each year to maintain a handicap, but it is each player's responsibility to return acceptable scores reflecting their demonstrated ability.

THE BOOKING SYSTEM

1. All tee times must be booked in advance through the booking system on the ClubV1 Members Hub.

2. Tee times become live on the booking system at 8 a.m. three days in advance e.g. Tuesday at 8 a.m. for times on Thursday.

3. There is a ten minute interval between times and matches start on the hour and at ten past, twenty past etc.

4. All matches must start at the first tee and have priority.

5. The clock in the Clubhouse window is the starting clock.

8. If planning to play more than 9 holes, members 4 BALL RESTRICTIONS should check that the tee will be open to allow a second nine. It may be shut for competitions, matches or meetings. It would be advisable in this particular case to book a second starting time when the tee re-opens.

The tee may be blocked off at certain times on competition days or when matches are being played. Members should check in advance through the booking system. The aim is to ensure that competitors have time and space to play and that the tee should be open as far as possible for other members to play.

PLAYING IN COMPETITIONS

Failure to turn up for a competition for which an entry has been made may result in the member being barred from playing in similar competitions. It is the responsibility of the individual member entering a competition to ensure that he/she has confirmed his/her starting time.

Club competitions are normally played from white observing an acceptable standard of dress at all tees (gents) and red tees (ladies). All other games times. must be played from yellow tees except as

From 1st March to 30th September no 4-ball matches are allowed on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Saturdays when a Ladies' or Gentlemen's Competition is being played.

PACE OF PLAY

Members should always aim to avoid falling behind the game in front by a hole or more. Players should be aware if their match is holding up matches behind them. It is so helpful if players invite a following match to play through at an appropriate moment. Members should also give those playing ties priority and let them play through when appropriate. We cannot all play at Members should enter competitions by the same pace but we can all be aware of our pace of play.

DRESS REGULATIONS

Members and their guests are asked to dress in a manner appropriate to the game of golf.

Smart casual dress is required. Denim jeans are not allowed. With the exception of juniors, golf shoes are required on the course. The Secretary and members of the Council have the right to refuse entry to any person who, in their view, is
